Updates from Delta Dental of Iowa

Hawki Annual Benefit Maximum

Effective May 31, 2025, the Hawki annual benefit maximum (ABM) will expire. All prior authorizations and dates of services claims on June 1, 2025, and thereafter will not have an annual benefit maximum applied. Members will no longer have an out-of-pocket responsibility when covered services exceed \$1,000 in one benefit period. We are educating our members about this change on our website and in their member materials. We encourage you to also educate your patients about these changes and how they impact their treatment plan.

You do not need to re-submit prior authorizations submitted and approved before May 31, 2025. The claim for services completed on date of services of June 1 or later will reflect the expiration of the ABM. You can choose to resubmit if you would like to see the ABM expiration reflected on the prior authorization.

Annual Choice for DWP and DWP Kids

The annual Open Choice Period for eligible DWP and DWP Kids members began this month. During this time, eligible DWP and DWP Kids members can switch their dental carrier for any reason. Any dental carrier changes made during this period will be **effective July 1, 2025, or later.**

All DWP and DWP Kids members eligible for the annual choice period will receive a mailing from Iowa Medicaid in April or May that includes the member's current dental carrier assignment and how to change dental carriers. If your patients have questions, they should contact Iowa Medicaid if they do not receive a mailing or need additional assistance with making their dental carrier choice.
